Purpose of the meeting was to review and discuss further the proposed amended Solid Waste By-Law as presented by Waste Coordinator Val Kean in conjunction with M & E Legal Services.

Call to order

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Huskilson at 7:25 p.m.

Solid Waste By-Law

Mayor Huskilson opened the floor for discussion regarding the proposed By-Law. Deputy Mayor Townsend had suggestions for amendments to what the draft By-Law included. The majority of his suggestions pertained to burning yard waste. Mayor Huskilson also had some issues with the lack of burning regulations being identified within the By-Law. It was suggested to the Waste Coordinator that either the Solid Waste By-Law must include guidelines for burning or we need to develop a Burning By-Law setting out regulations. Either way, we will require legal assistance in developing this document. Val Kean will research these concerns and provide Council with her findings.

Val Kean stated that the enforcement policy is very important and must provide the guidelines for enforcement which is to include the levels of enforcement.

Council did not give the Solid Waste By-Law first reading.
