## BY-LAW NUMBER 30

## CLOSING A PORTION OF SPRUCE STREET

- That the Council do close to public use a portion of a street known as Spruce Street.
- 2. That the portion of the said street hereby closed to public use pursuant to Section 1 of this By-Law is as follows:

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Lockeport, in the County of Shelburne in the Province of Nova Scotia, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the North East corner of lands now or formerly owned by Rupert G. Sutherland,

Thence running in an Easterly direction along lands owned by the Lockeport Division, National Sea

Products Limited to the Point where Spruce Street meets Water Street,

Thence Northerly along said Water Street to a point where the North side of Spruce Street meets the said Water Street,

Thence Westerly along other lands owned by the Lockeport Division, National Sea Products Limited,

Thence Southerly across Spruce Street to the place of beginning.

3. That the portion of Spruce Street as described in Section 2 of this By-Law be closed and that all rights of public user heretofore as a street in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the Town may sell and convey the portion so closed.
