Centennial Day Camps

Activities have been planned for elementary aged children throughout the summer. Each Day-Camp theme will be based on activities that represent the last hundred years of Lockeport and the objects that make our town complete. Daily activities include: crafts; games; sports; and outdoor recreation. These activities will be based at the Recreation Centre. Day camp activities will run Monday to Friday in the morning from 9am until 12pm and in the afternoon from 1pm to 4pm. We are also offering supervised play periods for those who need to drop off children earlier or pick them up later than the standard program times. Supervised play will be available 8:30am-9:00am, 12:00pm-1:00pm and 4:00pm-5:00pm, Monday to Friday. Registration for Youth Day Camps is due by the Friday before each week. Day-Camp Registration Fee: \$45 for the first program week, \$40/week for the subsequent weeks (\$30/week/additional child.) Special rates for the whole summer - Children who would like to sign up for all eight weeks of the Day-Camps can do so on or before Friday, July 6 at a fee of \$240/child (\$180/additional child). [Daily rates for the day camps are \$10/child and per half day is \$6/child.]
