

RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Lockeport that the following bye-law be, and the same is hereby enacted, and that the Clerk be, and he is hereby instructed, to forward said bye-law to the Honourable Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia with a request for his approval hereof.

Bye Law Number 29

- 1. In this bye-law:
"Person" means males or females of any age.
- 2. All persons are prohibited from entering upon the lot of land owned by the Town of Lockeport bounded South by Beach Street, West by Howe Street, North by Lands of Charles M. Stuart, Ruth Harding & Mrs. Margaget Francis, East by Hall Street, for the purpose of playing any games involving the use of a ball of any size and are prohibited from playing said games on the said property.
- 3. Any person who violates any provision of this bye-law shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and in default of such Penalty to be imprisoned for a period not exceeding forty-five (45) days.
