



Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Lockeport that the following by-law be and the same is hereby enacted and the Town Clerk be and is hereby instructed to forward same to the Minister of Highways and the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

By-Law Number 27

A by-law to close a portion of the public Town Street known as Beech Street Extension.

That portion of the public Town Street, known as Beech Street Extension, beginning at the South West corner of the Teacherage Property, so called, and running in a southerly direction to Locke Street, so called, bounded on the East by the Elementary School Grounds and on the West by the waters of the harbour is hereby closed to public use forever and will become a part of the Elementary School Ground to make room for a proposed new Elementary School Building.
