



RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Lockeport that Chapter 7 of the by-laws of the said Town be amended by striking out S. 9 through 14 and substituting the following amendments:

9. Any one not a ratepayer may be excluded from such meeting.

9 (a) The clerk shall provide an alphabetical list in duplicate of the ratepayers entitled to vote at such meeting, one of which shall be in the possession of the Mayor or Chairman and the other in the possession of the Clerk, and any ratepayer whose name is improperly omitted from the said list shall have his name inserted by the Clerk.

(b) Forthwith after the day has been fixed for a meeting, the town Clerk shall cause to be printed or typed such a number of ballot papers as shall be sufficient for the purpose of the voting.

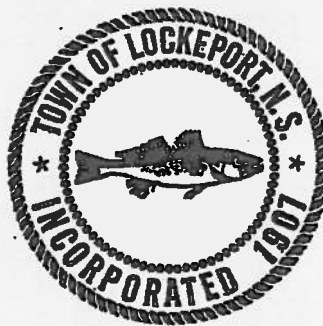
(c) The ballot papers shall be according to the form of Schedule "A" hereto.

(d) The Mayor or some person authorized by him in writing shall preside at the taking of the poll and the Town Clerk shall act as Poll Clerk. The Mayor shall also appoint two ratepayers as scrutineers, who shall be present with the presiding officer and Clerk during the voting.

(e) When the time for a vote has arrived the poll shall be held and the votes shall be taken by ballot.

(f) At the close of the poll the presiding officer shall in the presence of the scrutineers and poll clerk open the ballot box and count the votes, of which the Clerk and scrutineers shall keep tally and at the end of the counting the presiding officer shall declare the result.

(g) After counting the ballots the presiding officer shall return them to the box in the presence of the scrutineers after having ascertained the number of votes polled, the number who voted "for" and the number who voted "against" and the number of spoiled votes and shall seal the ballot box and shall retain the same in his custody for the period of one month when, if not called upon by competent authority to produce the same, he may destroy the ballots.



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(h) Printed directions in form of Schedule "b" hereto shall be posted up at the place of voting before the holding of the poll:

Schedule "B"

Directions for the guidance of voters: The voters will go into a compartment with a pencil provided therein, place a cross (thus X) on the right hand side, in upper space if he votes in favor of the resolution and the lower space if he voted against it.

The voter will then fold up the ballot paper and deliver it to the Presiding Officer and forthwith quit the voting place.

The following form of ballot paper is given for illustration. The voter has marked his ballot in favor of the resolution.
